Prayer of Confession • Psalm 23:1-3; Isaiah 53:6; Jer 50:6; Zech 10:2; John 10:27; 2 Tim 4:3-4; Heb 3:12-14

Leader: Lord, you are our Shepherd, who restores our souls and leads us in paths of righteousness,

yet we often refuse your guidance.

People: We often fear evil, for we flee your presence and lack the assurance of your protection.

Leader: Your Word says that we have all gone astray like sheep, turning to our own paths.

People: Forgive us for our wandering hearts that seek fulfillment apart from you.

Leader: As shepherds, we have sometimes led your people astray, removing them from the

protection of your fold and exposing them to danger.

People: We have sometimes listened to false shepherds who attract our attention by appealing

to our passions.

Leader: Help us to heed your voice and follow you, so that we may enjoy your protection and

be assured that no one will snatch us out of your hand.

All: Keep us from hardening our hearts so that we may not fall away from you. Give us

the grace to keep our confidence in you to the end. Amen.

God Teaches Us Through His Word

Scripture Reading • 1 Peter 5:1-11

So I exhort the elders among you, as a fellow elder and a witness of the sufferings of Christ, as well as a partaker in the glory that is going to be revealed: shepherd the flock of God that is among you, exercising oversight, not under compulsion, but willingly, as God would have you; not for shameful gain, but eagerly; not domineering over those in your charge, but being examples to the flock. And when the chief Shepherd appears, you will receive the unfading crown of glory. Likewise, you who are younger, be subject to the elders. Clothe yourselves, all of you, with humility toward one another, for "God opposes the proud but gives grace to the humble."

Humble yourselves, therefore, under the mighty hand of God so that at the proper time he may exalt you, casting all your anxieties on him, because he cares for you. Be sober-minded; be watchful. Your adversary the devil prowls around like a roaring lion, seeking someone to devour. Resist him, firm in your faith, knowing that the same kinds of suffering are being experienced by your brotherhood throughout the world. And after you have suffered a little while, the God of all grace, who has called you to his eternal glory in Christ, will himself restore, confirm, strengthen, and establish you. To him be the dominion forever and ever. Amen.

God's People Respond in Grateful Praise

God Nourishes His People at His Table

God offers to His people the gift of communion with Him through the grace of the sacrament and we respond in thanksgiving.

Guidelines for the Lord's Supper. The Lord's Supper is the family meal for Christians. We invite all Christians who are members of a congregation that proclaims the gospel, and who are at peace with God and with their neighbor, and who seek strength to live more faithfully for Christ to join us. If you are not a Christian, or if you are not prepared to share in this meal, we encourage you to spend this time in prayer. Suggested prayers are provided below.

At Walker's Chapel, we come forward to receive communion. Come as directed until the spaces around the rail are all taken. Groups will be dismissed together, at which point another group can gather at the rail. Wine or juice are both available depending on your conviction. Wine is on the outside ring of the tray, and juice is in the middle section. You may kneel if you so desire, but this is not required.

Prayers for Those Not Taking the Lord's Supper

If you are not able to partake in the Lord's Supper today, please use this time to meditate on one of the following prayers.

Prayer for Those Searching for Truth. Lord Jesus, you claim to be the way, the truth, and the life. Grant that I might be undaunted by the cost of following you as I consider the reasons for doing so. If what you claim is true, please guide me, teach me, and open me to the reality of who you are. Give me an understanding of you that is coherent, convincing, and that leads to the life you promise. Amen

Prayer of Belief. Lord Jesus Christ, I admit that I am weaker and more sinful than I ever dared admit, but through you I am more loved and accepted than I ever dared hope. I thank you for paying my debt on the cross, taking what I deserved in order to offer me complete forgiveness. Knowing that you have been raised from the dead, I turn from my sins and receive you as my Savior and Lord. Amen

Prayer of Commitment. Lord Jesus, you have called us to follow you in baptism and in a life of committed discipleship through regular assembly with your people. Grant that I may take the necessary steps to be one with your people, and live in the fullness of your Spirit. Amen

After calling His people into His presence, forgiving their sins, and instructing them in His Word, God sends His people into the world to show His light in the darkness.


Hymn of Prayer • Lead On, O King Eternal (Hymnal, 580)
